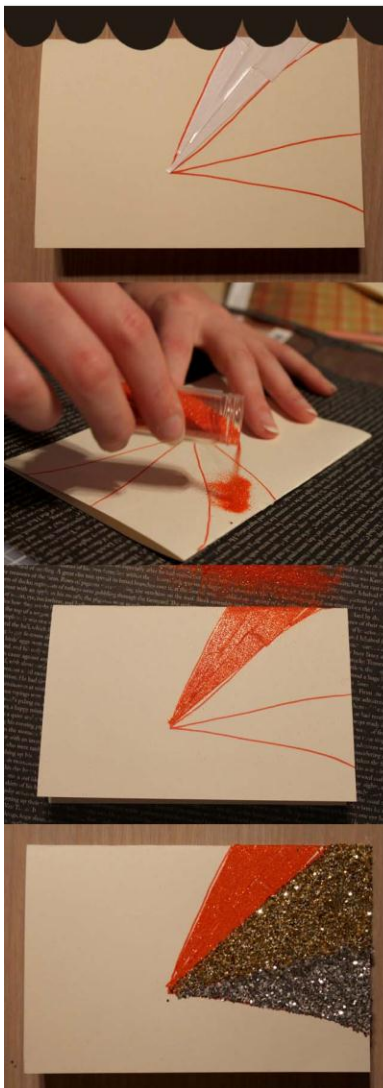

Everyone loves to send and receive cards, so why not make a fun glittery halloween card to send to you friend?

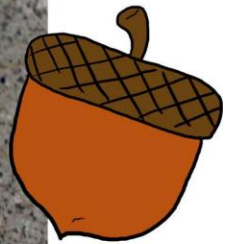


Tools and Supplies: 8"x6" piece of Cardstock, Double Stick Tape, Glitter, Embellishments, Scrapbook Stickers, Etc.



1. Fold your cardstock in half to create a card.
2. Sketch out a starburst or other shape on your card.
3. Add double stick tape in the area you want to glitter.
4. Sprinkle glitter heavily over your double stick tape.
5. Dust the extra glitter off.
6. Repeat with any other areas you want glittered, switching out different colors of glitter.
7. Finish decorating your card!

# AUTUMN BARK



## Ingredients:

1 Pound of Vanilla or Chocolate flavored Almond Bark

Pretzels

Caramel Bits (or other caramel candies)

M&M's (use only the red, yellow, orange, and brown ones!)

Edible Disco Dust (optional).



1. Line a cookie sheet or shallow baking pan with plastic wrap. Spray with non-stick vegetable cooking spray.

2. Chop almond bark into small pieces. Place in a microwave-safe bowl and melt 30 seconds at a time, stirring in between each.

3. Pour melted bark into pan and spread to smooth.

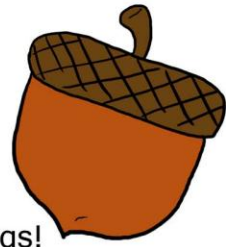
Sprinkle on all toppings.

Notes:

Sprinkle on the pretzels first because they're largest!

Be creative: use candy corn, popcorn, hershey bars, nuts, seeds, and other toppings!

Disco Dust can be ordered on many cake decorating supply shops. It is a non-toxic edible glitter.



# HALLOWEEN WREATH

Decorate your door for Halloween with a cute Candy Corn and Ghostie wreath! These little guys will put a smile on all of your friends faces when they see this wreath hanging on your front door.



Tools and Supplies:  
Wreath, Patterened Paper and  
Cardstock, Ribbon, Scissors, Glue.



1. Sketch out a ghost and a candy corn onto paper to use as a pattern. You want them about 3" tall.



2. Cut the ghosts out of white paper, and the candy corn from orange, yellow and white papers. Piece them together.



3. Arrange and adhere them to your wreath. You can use a real wreath or cut a 12" circle from cardstock with a 6" hole in the middle.



4. Cut a 6" piece of ribbon and glue the 2 ends to the top back side of your wreath.

5. Flip your wreath over and hang on your door!

Ingredients:

Pumpkin Seeds, Pretzels,  
Candy Corn.

1. Rinse pumpkin seeds under cold water and pick out the pulp and strings.
2. Place the pumpkin seeds on a non stick baking sheet, Lightly spray non stick cooking spray over the seeds as well.
3. Sprinkle with salt and bake at 325 degrees F until toasted, about 25 minutes, checking and stirring after 10 minutes.
4. Let cool and mix with pretzels, candy corn and other fall yummys.



# MUMMY CANDLES TUTORIAL:

These spooky candles are perfect for your Halloween party, or just to decorate a room with.

Tools and Supplies: White Pillar Candles, White Fabric, Black Ink, Googly Eyes, Hot Glue Gun, Scissors.



1. Cut your white fabric into 1" wide strips.

2. Glue one end of a fabric strip to the top of a candle, and wrap the fabric strip around the candle, gluing the end down.



3. Glue 2 googly eyes onto your candle.



4. Continue glueing on fabric strips, wrapping them around your candle until most of it is covered.

Only cover the edge of the eyes.



5. Lightly run the ink over your candle to give your mummy more texture.
